CAMBRIDGE SUBWAY OPEN.

Connects Harvard Square and Park Street, Boston—Cost \$11,750,000.

BOSTON, March 23.—The new Cambridge Subway, which forms an important addition to the transit facilities of Boston, was formally opened to the public to-day. The route extends from Harvard Square, Cambridge, to Park Street, Boston, a distance of 3.2 miles.

Work was started on the Subway on July 12, 1909, and the cost has been \$11,750,000.
